Directions to Sidney Smith Hall (100 St. George Street)

Directions for Driving:

From within the city:

- On College heading westbound (from University): Turn right at St. George St., which is at the second set of stop lights west of University. Follow St. George St. to Sidney Smith Hall, which is just past the first set of lights on the left hand side of the road.
- On College heading eastbound (from Spadina): Since there is no left turn sign at St. George St., turn left at Spadina. Follow Spadina around the circle and continue until the second set of lights, which is Harbord . Turn right on Harbord. Follow Harbord until the second set of lights, which is St. George St. Turn left on St. George for underground parking (see below). Turn right on St. George to get to Sidney Smith Hall. Sidney Smith Hall is the second building on the right hand side of the road.
- On Bloor heading westbound (from Avenue Rd. or Yonge St.): Turn left at St. George St, which is at the at the second set of stop lights west of Avenue Rd. Follow St. George St. to Sidney Smith Hall, which is the second building on the right hand side of the road just past Harbord.
- On Bloor heading eastbound (from Spadina): Turn right at St. George St, which is at the at the third set of stop lights east of Spadina. Follow St. George St. to Sidney Smith Hall, which is the second building on the right hand side of the road just past Harbord.

From outside the city:

- From West of Toronto: Take the QEW to the Gardner Expressway towards Toronto. Exit at Spadina St and turn left. As you drive along Spadina, you will pass King, Queen, Dundas, and College (major intersections). Once you pass College, follow Spadina around the circle and continue until the second set of stop lights, which is Harbord. Turn right on Harbord. Follow Harbord until the second set of stop lights, which is St. George St. Turn left on St. George for underground parking. Turn right on St. George to get to Sidney Smith Hall. Sidney Smith Hall is the second building on the right hand side of the road.
- From East or West of Toronto: Take the 401 east/west and exit at Avenue Road (also called Highway 11A). Go South along Avenue towards Bloor St. (this is a fairly long drive). Turn right onto Bloor St. Follow Bloor until St. George St, which is at the second set of stop lights. George St. to Sidney Smith Hall, which is the second building on the right hand side of the road just past Harbord.

Parking:

Parking is available at the Rotman building, which is across from Robarts Library. The entrance to
this underground lot is the second driveway north of Harbord St. on the right hand side of the
road. The cost of the parking will be posted on a display above the entrance. This is also metered
parking available on Huron Street (behind Sidney Smith Hall) for \$2.50/hour with a maximum of
three hours. On King's College Circle, there is also metered parking fro \$3.00/1.2 hour. Upon
request, it may be possible to reserve a free parking spot from the Psychology Department,
although this is never guaranteed to be available for a given study time.

Directions for taking the Subway:

- Get off at St. George Station. Exit at the St. George Street exit (not the Bedford Road exit) and turn left. Walk south along St. George until the second set of lights, which is Harbord Street. Sidney Smith Hall is located at 100 St. George St, which is the second building south of Harbord on the right hand side of the road.
- Alternative: Get off at Castle Frank Station / Wellesley Station / Ossington Station. Take the Wellesley bus #94, which goes along Harbord Street between Ossington Station and Castle Frank Station. Get off the bus at St. George Street. Sidney Smith Hall is located at 100 St. George St, which is the second building south of Harbord on the right hand side of the road.
